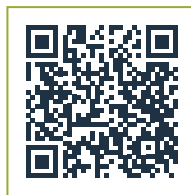

Travel across Europe and beyond

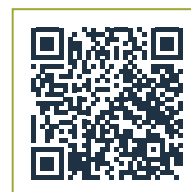

Employment options during your studies

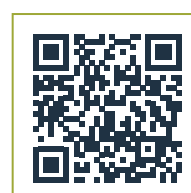

Accommodation and student life

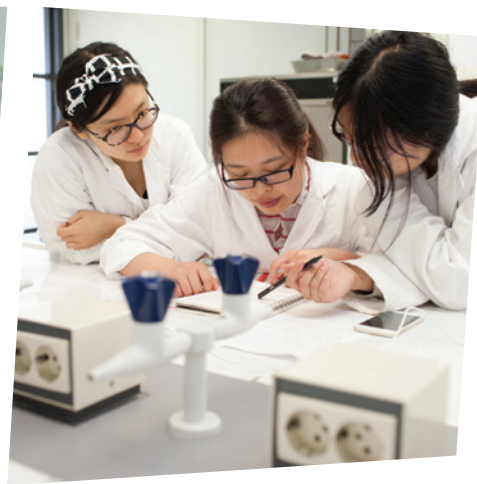

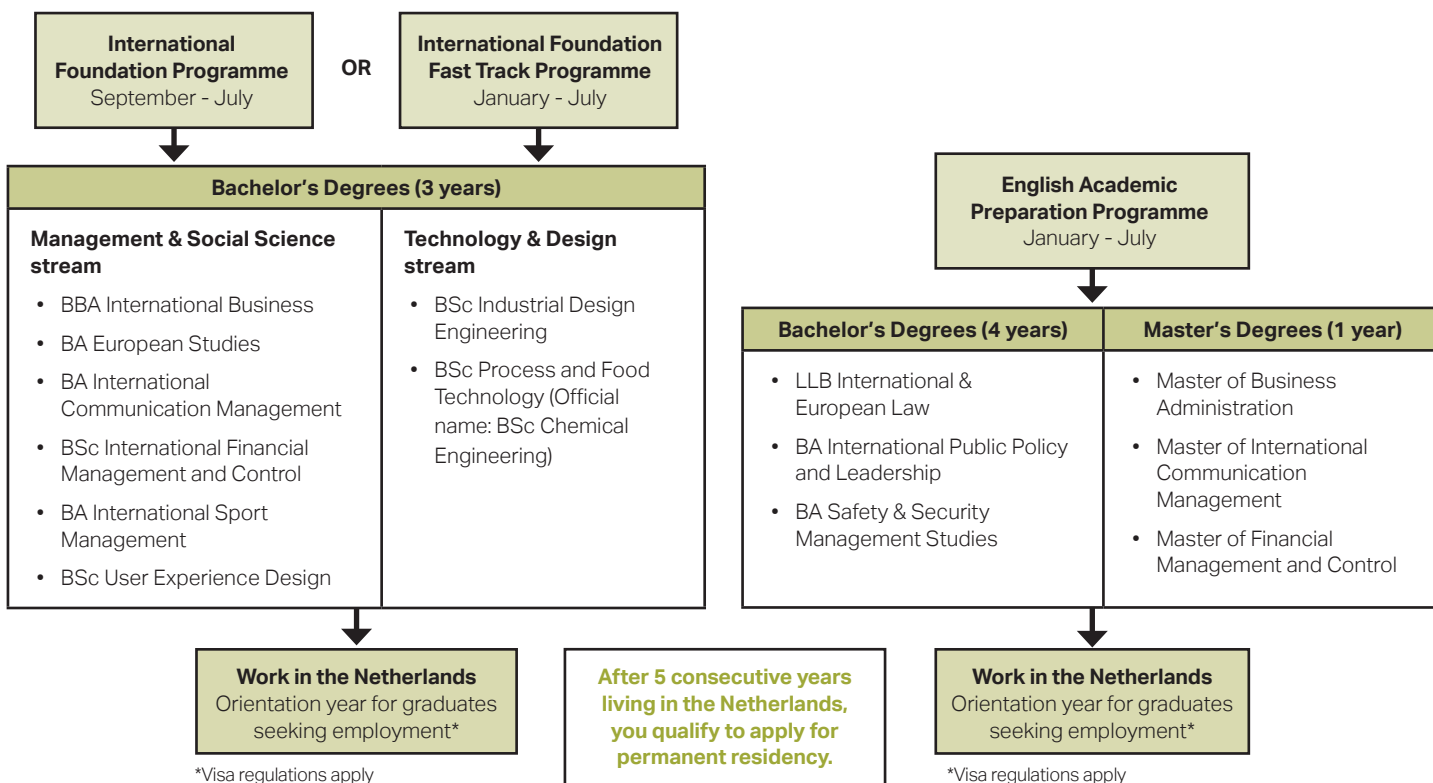

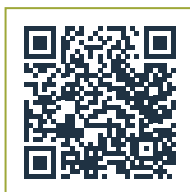
